

# Chitose Aquarium, a Birthplace of Salmon

This aquarium features one of the largest freshwater tanks in Japan. See freshwater fish from Hokkaido and other freshwater organisms from around the world.

At the Underwater Observation Zone, the first of its kind in Japan, observe living creatures in the Chitose River from up close all year round. In autumn, the schools of salmon migrating upstream to spawn are not to be missed.

An event in which young salmon are released and many other events and projects are held at this aquarium, which is popular among people of all ages.

◇Access: an approx. 10-minute drive from New Chitose Airport, an approx. 10-minute walk from JR Chitose Station, an approx. 60-minute drive from Sapporo

Individuals: 800 yen for adults; 500 yen for high schoolers; 300 yen for elementary and junior high schoolers; free for infants

Groups of 10 or more people: 600 yen for adults; 400 yen for high schoolers; 200 yen for elementary and junior high schoolers

◇Hours: 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

◇Closed: year-end and New Year holidays, holidays for maintenance
